



Work with Chemical Substances and Chemical Mixtures

For all the interested employees through group leaders

Based on the requirements of the Public Health Authority for the Capital City of Prague and in compliance with legal norms (Act No. 350/2011 Coll. on Chemical Substances and Chemical Mixtures, Act No. 258/2000 Coll. on Public Health Protection, as amended by Act No. 267/2015 Coll. and the Regulations (EC) No. 1272/2008 (CLP/GHS), No. 790/2009 and No. 286/2011),

I ORDER the following:

All the staff of the IOCB of the AS CR, v.v.i., (IOCB) working with chemical substances and chemical mixtures in the sense of the above-mentioned legal norms must be demonstrably acquainted with Attachments 1–3 to this Director's Order. This obligation also concerns persons that work at the IOCB laboratories but are not IOCB employees (e.g. Master's students, interns, foreign visitors, etc.). Training shall be conducted by group leaders by July 30, 2016. New employees shall be acquainted with the above-mentioned attachments during their induction training. A list of the names of the employees demonstrably acquainted with these attachments (in the form of an attendance sheet or the training record) shall be kept by individual scientific group leaders.

The attachments to this Director's Order must at all times be accessible to all the staff, including foreigners working at the IOCB. For them, the mentioned attachments are available in an English version. Before beginning the work, all the staff must be acquainted with the hazardous properties of substances according to the above-mentioned attachments and follow the instructions for safe work. The information contained in the attachments concerned serves for guidance only and does not supersede other detailed information listed e.g. in the literature or material safety data sheets.
