

**EMERGENCY PLAN**  
**ÚOCHB AV ČR, v.v.i., Flemingovo nám. 2, Praha 6**

1. **Everyone**, who finds out an emergency or breakdown of technical equipment (escape of toxic, aggressive or flammable gases, damage to installation of water, gas and electric current, stable pressure bottles and others), is obliged to take immediately such measures in order to protect health of employees and to protect material values.

In cases of serious danger of damage to health employees do not take any action but immediately inform about the emergency a head of department who sends all unauthorized persons off the endangered premises and depending on actual situation he/she gives instructions to remove a cause or a source of the emergency, to cleanse the contaminated premises or to evacuate all the employees from the place of emergency.

2. **The premises contaminated by toxic or aggressive gases may be entered by** in principle at least 2 employees with breathing apparatuses, put on outside the contaminated premises, who must be secured by another person. During non-working time a doorkeeper must be informed in advance about the entry into the contaminated premises and the doorkeeper is obliged to call help of other present employees.

The same measures apply also in case of entry of persons into the premises endangered with explosion of flammable gases or vapors.

3. **The following persons must be informed about every emergency or an operation accident**

- Institute director or vice director **local extension 333, 444**
- Safety engineer of ÚOCHB AV ČR, v.v.i. **local extension 254**
- Manager of technical section of ÚOCHB AV ČR, v.v.i. **local extension 404**

These persons shall decide about announcement of the whole premises alarm, partial or total evacuation of the premises; they shall issue a ban of entry of persons or vehicles into the premises or a ban of connection of phone calls.
