Call info	The EMBO Long-Term Fellowships are awarded for a period of up to two years and support post-doctoral research visits to laboratories throughout Europe and the world. International exchange is a key feature in the application process.
Conditions / Restrictions	Applicant must hold a PhD degree or equivalent at the start of the fellowship, at the latest. The PhD degree must have been obtained during the two years prior to the application deadline (10 Feb 2016 – 30 Jun 2018/31 Dec 2018). Exceptions to this rule are made for applicants with prolonged career breaks due to parental leave, etc. Applicant must have at least one first (or joint first) author research paper accepted for publication or published in an international peer reviewed journal at the time the application is complete (Fri 09 Feb 2018). Application must involve a change of country . Applicant can apply if he/she has already started working in the host laboratory, but only if he/she has been working there for less than six months at the time the application deadline (10 Aug 2017 – 09 Feb 2018). Applicant needs to register for an EMBO online application account. Once login details for the account have been received it is possible to start an application. Figures and tables cannot be included in the application. Applicant may only submit one application , for one project, at one host laboratory at each round of selection. Applicant should list and activate two referees and the receiving institute contact person as soon as possible, preferably 4 weeks prior to the deadline. It is responsibility of the applicant to check that the referees and the receiving institute have received the request and complete the form. It is the applicant's responsibility to arrange the interview with the interviewer and to make sure they have all required documents in order before they travel. Applicant may be requested to give a seminar as part of the interview procedure.
Proposal consists of	I) Online Application Form via the EMBO online system, https://applications.embo.org/register.php?reg=S019 : (1) applicant; (2) contact details for two referees; (3) contact details for the receiving institute: supervisor, 3 key publications of the host laboratory, personal motivation; (4) proposed work: a 250-word summary, a 1500-word synopsis of the proposed activity, keywords, ethical information; (5) present position & home institute; (6) PhD award; (7) other funding sources; (8) scientific CV: research experience, education, publications; (9) further eligibility details II) Two reference letters: one must be from the PhD supervisor, none can come from referees in the receiving institute III) Acceptance letter from the receiving institute
Evaluation criteria	Scientific achievements of the applicant, project proposal, host laboratory (1) Publications and CV of the applicant. (2) Performance of the applicant based on reference letters. (3) Quality, novelty and biological significance of the proposed research. (4) Coherent and logical presentation of the research project. (5) Applications to continue exploring a topic similar to the PhD project, usually receive lower priority for funding. (6) Suitability of the host laboratory for the proposed research project and training of the applicant. (7) Scientific achievements of the host laboratory.
