Applicants who have already been sponsored by the Humboldt Foundation are not eligible to apply for the Humboldt Research Fellowship Programme but should turn to the Foundation's Alumni Programme for support for further research stays. It is responsibility of PI to check that two referees and host institution have received the request and complete the form and send the form directly to the foundation.
