Call info	The aim of the programme is to establish contacts, to develop cooperation and support the mobility of researchers cooperating in international projects of basic research.
Conditions / Restrictions	The tender documentation is only available in Czech. The proposal for a joint research project has to be prepared simultaneously by the Czech research team (based on MEYS call conditions) and the foreign investigators (based on Programme Barrande 2018 conditions). The Czech and French parts of the project must be identical in terms of content and themes. Several Czech research institutions can participate, however only one main proposer has to be designated on the Czech side of joint research project. The proposal has to be submitted only via data box (datová schránka) vidaawt . The proposal has to be originally signed, stamped and dated by the institution's legal representatives of all participating Czech institutions.
