Call info	The main objective of the MUNI Award is to bring to the Masaryk University in Brno new excellent and successful scientists to increase the university research potential and prestige.
Conditions / Restrictions	Applications must be sent to Masaryk university via e-mail <a href="mailto:gamu@muni.cz">gamu@muni.cz</a> until the deadline. The Award holder will be offered Tenure Track Professorship with the budget of <b>1 000 000 EUR</b> for the period of 5 years, laboratory and office space, and access to the state-of-the-art research equipment. The award holder is supposed to have a full-time job at the Masaryk University. Preference will be given to applicants whose research falls within the fields existing at the Masaryk University.
