Call info	Program aims to support development of collaboration of the CAS institutes with research institutions in Germany.
Conditions / Restrictions	Project proposals must be submitted in parallel to both partner organizations. CZ project proposal must be submitted (i) electronically to smilnicka@kav.cas.cz and (ii) in one printed hard copy signed by PI and IOCB director and addressed to Julie Smilnická. All Czech team members must be employees of the CAS. The research team members are divided into two categories: Category 1 (researchers, university teachers, postdocs) and category (2: PhD students, graduates - BA/MA). Maximum exchange quota per research team and calendar year is not assigned. Maximum length of one visit is up to 30 days for category 1 and up to 50 days for category 2.

	<p>Living expenses of Czech team in Germany will be covered by the DAAD: for category 1: EUR 89 per person per day (1st – 22nd day); or EUR 2,000 per person per month (23rd – 30th day); for category 2: EUR 54/40 per person per day (1st – 20th day, 31st – 50th day); or EUR 1,200 per person per month (21st -30th day). International transportation and travel insurance will not be covered by the CAS. At least 1/3 of all team members must be junior researchers or PhD students. PI can submit more than 1 project proposal, but only 1 project can be funded. Only 2 subsequent projects realized by the same research teams can be funded. The DAAD postponed the Deadline for submission to 29 June 2018.</p>
