Conditions / Restrictions	The tender documentation is only available in Czech. The proposal for a joint research project has to be prepared simultaneously by the Czech research team (based on MEYS call conditions : http://www.msmt.cz/vyzkum-a-vyvoj-2/vyzva-k-podavani-cesko-cinskyh-navrhu-projektu-spoluprace-2 and the foreign investigators (based on MOST conditions http://www.most.gov.cn/tztg/201805/t20180503_139283.htm). The Czech and Chinese parts of the project must be identical in terms of content and themes. The Chinese version of proposal has to be attached to Czech proposal. The proposal has to be submitted only via data box (datová schránka) vidaawt . The proposal has to be originally signed, stamped and dated by the institution's legal representatives of all participating Czech institutions.
