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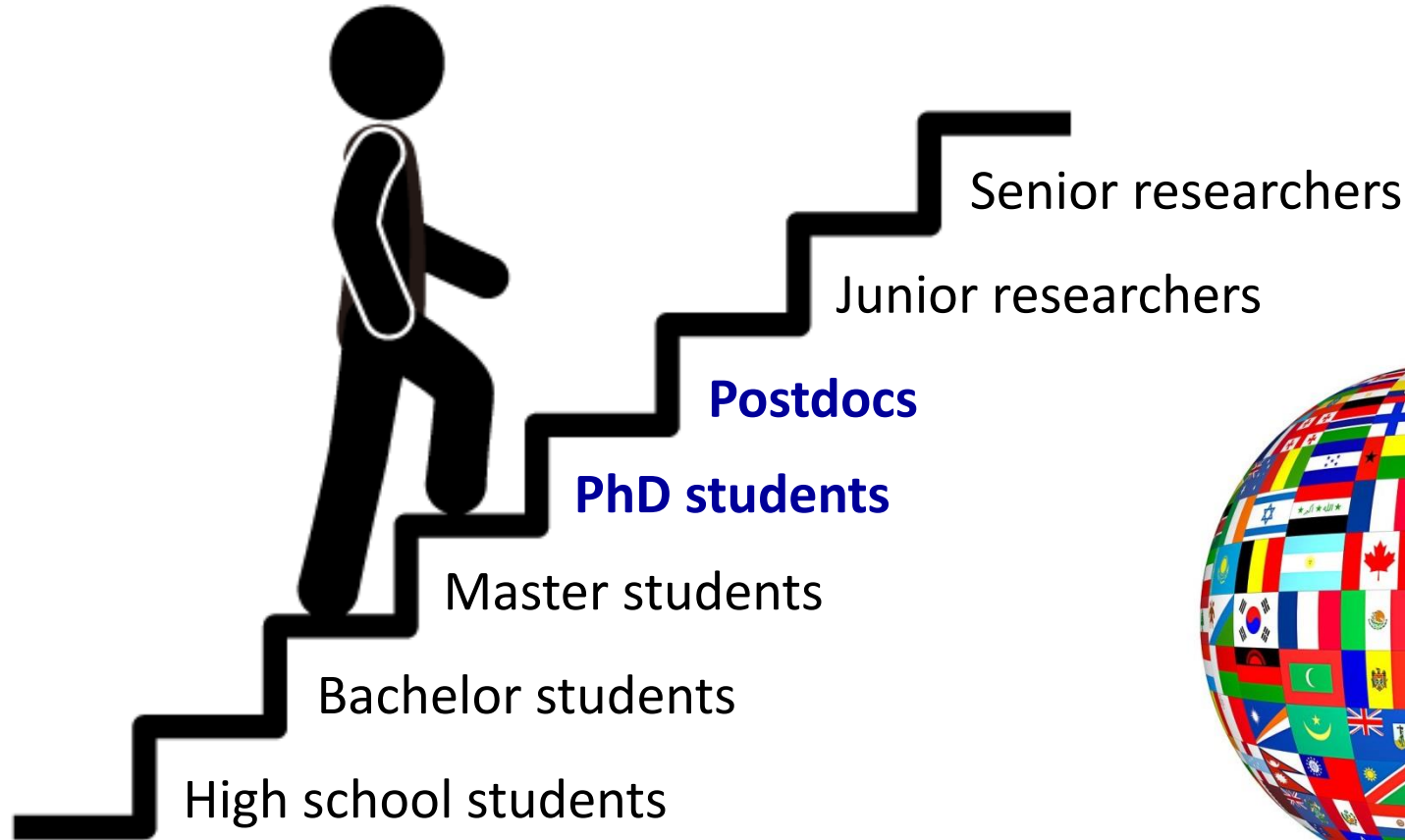

In the four years prior to their application, applicants should have spent at least **two consecutive years** outside the country in which they are planning to establish their laboratory.



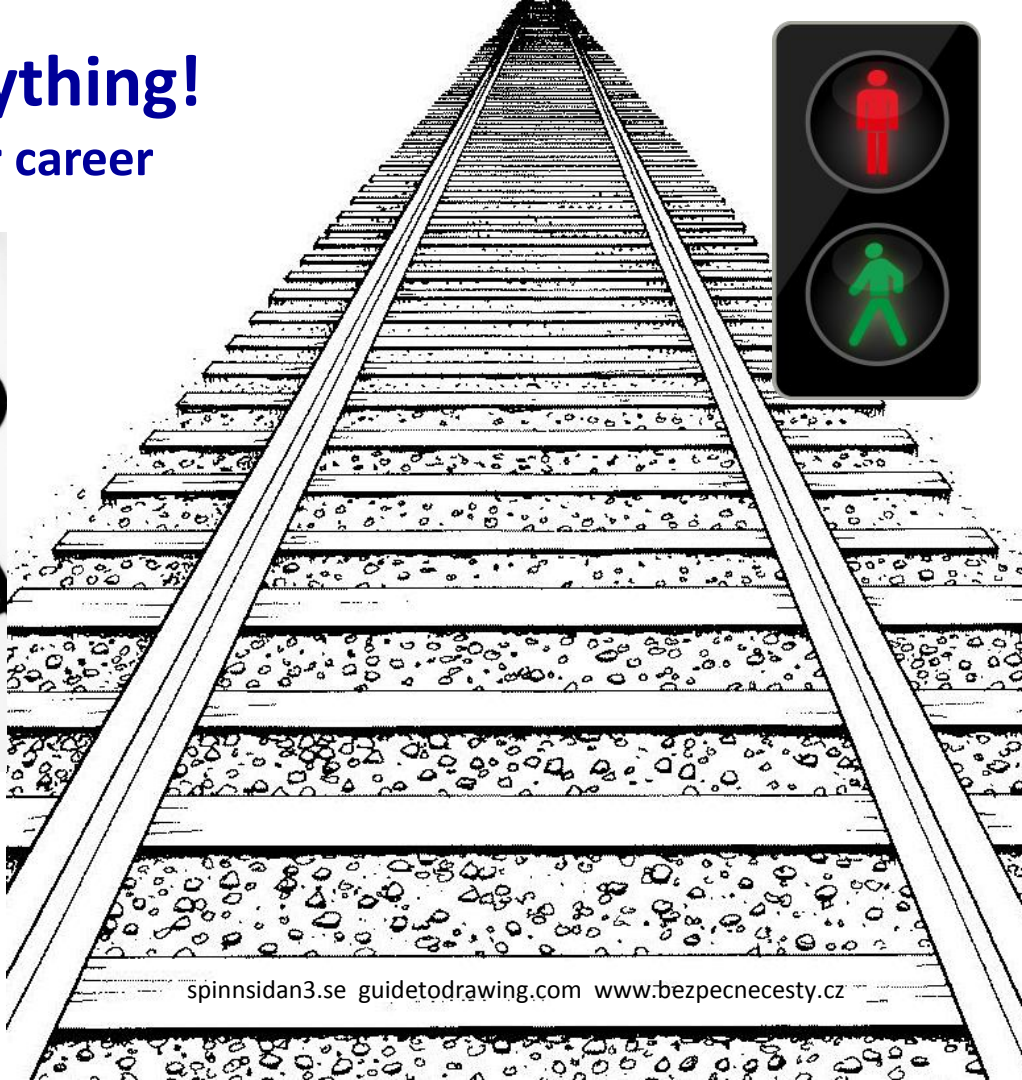
