European Fellows are expected to pursue a period of research in Japan whereas Japanese Fellows are expected to do their research in Europe (for example at the IOCB Prague).
Conditions / Restrictions	Canon Foundation Research Fellowships may be applied for when an agreement on cooperation and on a research plan has been reached between the guest researcher and the proposed host institution.  Applicants can be from commercial, industrial, governmental or professional organisations.
	Europeans should have permanent citizenship in the country.  Applicants should have obtained at least a Master's degree within the last ten years of applying to the Canon Foundation. We will also consider candidates who obtained their qualification more than ten years ago as long as they provide further supporting information
	in their application.  Priority is given to applicants going to Europe/Japan for the first time.  Candidates should be aware that it is not the Foundation's policy to award Fellowships to those who are already in possession of a concurrent research grant aid from another Foundation authority.
