	Fellowships are granted exclusively for on-site projects to carry out full-time research activity
	on the research centre's facilities. These fellowships are incompatible with any other paid
	work or fellowship, but there are compatible with any grant for research projects. The salary
	may be supplemented through other funding.

	• Contact details for 3 – 5 referees as at least three reference letters are required.
	• A declaration of interest letter signed by a researcher of the research center.
