Conditions / Restrictions	Applicants must be only Ph.D. students who are subscribed at Czech universities. Research visits have to start on the first day of each month. Dates of arrival & departure have to correspond to dates of beginning & closing of the visit. Applications have to be sent electronically as 1 folder with all documents to <a href="mailto:sciences.prague@gmail.com">sciences.prague@gmail.com</a> . Name the folder: "Surname-Name-Staz-SVT" Name each file: "Surname-Name-name-of-document" Personal interviews with selected applicants will be held in Prague in April 2018. Applicants are expected to present their research projects in 10-min presentations (max 7 slides) and answer all questions. Non-French speaking students may apply for the fellowship if the French supervisor confirms agreement of the French institution with the English. This programme aims to develop Czech-French collaboration. Fellows are expected to become important players and to strengthen Czech-French relationships.
