	required for submission in the Ph.D. study in France. The certificate is issued by the
	French university.
	Successful students will receive a Joint University Diploma accredited by both
	universities.

	5) Letter of Support from the French supervisor who will be responsible for the study, agreement with the supervision together with the Czech supervisor, confirmation to supervise student during his/her 3 5-month visits in France, dates of beginning & closing of the visits (French mentor)
