Conditions / Restrictions	The Joint Degree Ph.D. Study is prepared simultaneously by Czech and French university. All conditions are summarized in an "Agreement about Joint Degree Ph.D. Study" signed by both universities. Applicants must be Ph.D. students subscribed simultaneously at Czech and French universities. During 3 years, fellows spend time alternately on both universities. The Fellowship covers 3 5-month visits in France. Research visits have to start on 01 Oct 2019 or on 01 Nov 2019. Non-French speaking students may apply for the fellowship if the French supervisor confirms agreement of the French institution with the English. French university diploma "Master de recherche" (ex-DEA) or a Certificate of equivalence of the Czech university diploma with the French university diploma is required for submission in the Ph.D. study in France. The certificate is issued by the French university. Successful students will receive a Joint University Diploma accredited by both universities.
