Australian recipients must not undertake their Leadership in a country where they hold citizenship/dual citizenship or permanent residency. International recipients must not hold citizenship/dual citizenship or permanent residency of Australia. Individual applicants may apply for more than one category in each round; however they must submit a separate application for each and may only submit one application per category. It is the responsibility of the recipient to ensure they obtain the correct visa type and to meet any visa application costs. International recipients undertaking an Endeavour Postgraduate or an Endeavour Vocational Education and Training Leadership Award generally apply for an international
