Call info	The Korean Government Scholarship Program (KGSP) provides higher education in Korea for international students with the aim of promoting international exchange in education, as well as fostering mutual friendship amongst the participating countries.	
Conditions / Restrictions		
Proposal consists of	flight tickets or the Scholarship Completion Grants. A KGSP scholar who forfeit and withdraws from the scholarship within the first 3 months after entering Korea MUST return the full scholarship fees that he/she has received during the mentioned period. It will include the airfare from one's home country to Korea, the settlement allowance, monthly allowance, language training fees, medical insurance fees, and tuition. The application documents must be submitted in the order of the checklist on the first page of the application form. Each required document must be numbered on the top right corner. Applicants must submit 1 set of original application and 3 sets of photocopies, identical to the original set. For sealed documents, such as recommendation letters, applicants must submit 4 identical documents, each sealed in a separate envelope.
