Call info	The Korean Government Scholarship Program (KGSP) provides higher education in Korea for international students with the aim of promoting international exchange in education, as well as fostering mutual friendship amongst the participating countries.
Conditions / Restrictions	<p>The Embassy Track applicants must submit their application documents to the Embassy of the Republic of Korea in their respective countries of citizenship (AIA in the Czech Republic). Applicants and their parents must hold non-Korean citizenship.</p> <p>Applicants must be under 40 years of age as of Sep 01, 2018 (born after Sep 01, 1978). Applicants must hold or must be expecting to hold a Bachelor's, Master's or a Doctoral degree by Fri 31 Aug 2018. Applicants who are expected to obtain the degree must first submit the certificate of expected graduation at the time of applying. The official degree certificate or diploma must be submitted by Fri 31 Aug 2018.</p> <p>Applicants who have been enrolled in Korean universities as exchange students are eligible to apply.</p> <p>Applicants must maintain the overall grade point average (CGPA) equivalent to or higher than 80% score percentile.</p> <p>Applicants must be in a good health, both mentally and physically, to study in Korea for the full duration of degree or research program.</p> <p>Applicants must submit Form 6 or the "Personal Medical Assessment" at the time of applying. All applicants who pass the 2nd round of selection must submit the results of the Comprehensive Medical Examination conducted by a doctor or a licensed physician.</p> <p>Former applicants who had withdrawn from the scholarship after being selected as KGSP scholar in the past are strictly NOT eligible to apply.</p> <p>Applicants who have attained certified scores for their proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) or English (TOEFL, TOEIC, or IELTS Academic) may be given preference.</p> <p>Applicants must choose 3 desired universities as well as fields of study out of the 64 universities listed in section III of the guidelines.</p> <p>The scholarship period cannot and will not be extended.</p> <p>All application documents must be written either in Korean or in English. Documents written in languages other than Korean or English must accompany a complete Korean or English translation, authenticated by the issuing institution or notarized by a notary public.</p> <p>All application documents must be presented in their original forms. If applicants have to submit the photocopied documents, the applicants MUST have the copies notarized or apostilled and then submit the notarized or apostilled copies. For any academic documents that cannot be reissued, applicants must submit the notarized or apostilled copies of the original version.</p> <p>Transferring to a different university under this scholarship is NOT, in any case, permitted. It is strictly forbidden to live with family members.</p> <p>A KGSP scholar who forfeits and withdraws from the scholarship will NOT receive the returning flight tickets or the Scholarship Completion Grants.</p> <p>A KGSP scholar who forfeit and withdraws from the scholarship within the first 3 months after entering Korea MUST return the full scholarship fees that he/she has received during the mentioned period. It will include the airfare from one's home country to Korea, the settlement allowance, monthly allowance, language training fees, medical insurance fees, and tuition.</p>

Each required document must be numbered on the top right corner. Applicants must submit 1 set of original application and 3 sets of photocopies, identical to the original set.
