| | Furthermore, the nominee should not have recently won any awards or fellowships |
| | in Germany for his or her academic accomplishments. At the time of nomination, the |
| | nominated candidate must have been predominantly living and working abroad for |
| | at least 5 years . Moreover, the nominees must not have held or accepted an offer |
| | of permanent employment in Germany prior to the selection date. |
| | Nominating academics must guarantee that they can provide the necessary |
| | infrastructure for the award winner's own research projects or lecture tours (e.g. |
| | access to libraries, materials, facilities). German hosts are also expected to be well |
| | prepared for the award winner's research stay and to act as his or her personal |
| | mentor (e.g. finding accommodation). |
