Call info	DFG Research Fellowships are intended to help early career researchers to conduct a defined project at a location of their choice in a country other than Germany and to use it as an opportunity to familiarise themselves with new research methods or to bring a large project to a conclusion.
Conditions / Restrictions	Applicants must have completed their PhD before application submission. Applicants have worked for at least 3 years in the German research system (doctoral or postdoctoral phase). Applicants must intend to continue their research career in Germany after the funding. Applicants are free to choose any country (except Germany) as destination for their research stay abroad, provided they have not resided or carried out their main activity in the same country no more than 3 years. Applicants must not have been working for the host institution selected for the research fellowship for more than 1 year. Applicants can apply for fellowships from other organisations, e.g. <u>www.daad.de</u> , <u>www.stiftungen.org</u> , <u>www.stifterverband.info</u> , <u>www.eduserver.de</u> , <u>www.euraxess.de</u> , etc. Secondary employment is only possible in exceptional cases.
