Call info	The Banting Postdoctoral Fellowships program provides funding to the very best postdoctoral applicants, both Canadian and internationally, who will positively contribute to the country's economic, social and research-based growth.
Conditions / Restrictions	Applicants who are not Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada may only hold their BPF at a Canadian institution. Applicants who are Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada and who obtained their PhD from a foreign university may only hold their BPF at a Canadian institution, whereas those who obtained their PhD from a Canadian university may hold their BPF at either a Canadian institution or an institution outside of Canada. Applicants must fulfil or have fulfilled all degree requirements for a PhD between Thu 15 Sep 2016 – Wed 30 Sep 2020, and before the start date of their award. Applicants who have not fulfilled all requirements for their degree at the time of application must submit proof no later than Thu 15 Oct 2020.
