Grant applications and parenthood

- ✓ Providers are aware of the difficulties incorporation of family friendly practices and policies into their programs to overcome obstacles.
- ✓ Complex issue of variable conditions such as personal needs, career phase, filed of research, country's legal framework.
- ✓ There is no universal formula of how to satisfy the double demands of work and family.
- ✓ Improvement of conditions over time.

Research funding opportunities for early career researchers

Fellowships (individual support)

Aim: to gain research experience abroad, research career development, research results - joint publication, networking

Responsibilities: fulfill fellowship guidelines, improve skills

Eligibility costs: travel and mobility allowance; (research money, salary, etc.)

Can I take my family with me? Are there a family incentives?

Grants (team support)

Aim: to get financial support to realize your research project

Responsibilities: achieve defined objectives, delivered outputs, manage project

in predetermine time

Eligibility costs: personnel and travel costs, consumables; (investments, etc.)

What to do, if I need a break for family/parental reasons?

Applicants - Eligibility criteria

Activities for early career researchers limitation by:

- ✓ time from obtaining PhD degree
- ✓ age

Maternity and parental leave, sick leave in case of long-term illness not included in limits stated above—more less standard

- variability in deadlines definition (call announcement, submission deadline, start of the project realization, calendar year, ...)
- extension by restricted period: days count, years count, lump sum,..
 count by days → clear indication in CV or in requested parts of a project
 proposal (exact dates not just years)
 hidden in the text e.g. active in research
- contact program officer case-by-case basis

FELLOWSHIPS

How to combine research stay abroad with family commitments?

Fellowships: eligibility costs - examples of family incentives

- ✓ travel expenses for family members Humboldt, FEBS, SCOL
- ✓ relocation costs for fellow & family HFSP
- ✓ family/child allowances Humboldt, MSCA, Fulbright, SCOL
- ✓ child care allowance (age variability) EMBO, HFSP, Humboldt
- √ flat-rate allowance (for single/parent) Humboldt
- ✓ assistance for children (% of annual stipends) FEBS
- ✓ parental leave 3 months paid EMBO, HFSP
- ✓ unpaid leave or part-time work EMBO, MSCA
- ✓ additional extension of fellowship (up to 12 months) Humboldt
- ✓ interruption and extension of the fellowship MSCA
- √ flexibility case-by-case basis Newton

How to combine research project with a break for a family/parental reasons?


Grants

Responsibility towards own research team x family x provider.

- ✓ temporary or permanent change of a Principal Investigator (throughout maternity/parental leave, etc.) GA ČR JUN, STD, INT
- ✓ temporary changes in capacity engagement of team member in project due to a
 maternity/parental leave OP VVV Excellent teams, GA ČR
- ✓ decrease of capacity from a full-time to a part-time job MSCA, OP VVV
- ✓ extension of a project duration in no-cost mode H2020, ERC
- ✓ postponed the final report delivery GA ČR
