Each national provider bears the costs of its own researchers. • Since it is the first French participation in this call, only the 2 or 3 selected projects obtaining the highest marks will receive French funding. Other selected French project holders may participate in the program only at their own expense. Their Austrian, Serbian, Slovak and Czech partners will receive financial support from their respective countries. • Proposals with the same content and thematic aspects will not be accepted if they have already been submitted and funded in the framework of bilateral or multilateral cooperation. • Complete project proposals and annexes in electronic format must be sent via data box. • The consent to the processing of personal data have to be originally signed by all members of the Czech research team. Guideline of good practices have to be signed by a statutory body • Costs have to be proposed in thousands of CZK (for MEYS budget)
