CryoEM

Cryo Electron Microscopy is the future of molecular structural studies

IOCB Board, Management and Scientists spearheaded access to the technology – in spite of space limitations at the IOCB campus

- Agreement with CEITEC
- Planned collaboration with BIOCEV to built and share a new facility

Original plan:

- Purchase a 200 keV instrument for screening and suitable applications at IOCB campus
- Share the acquisition and running costs of a 300 keV instrument with the Biotechnology Institute of the CAS, to be located at BIOCEV

CryoEM

Recent developments:

- An expert technician determined that there is a suitable space at IOCB to locate even a 300 keV instrument
- Biotechnology Inst. wasn't awarded infrastructure grant money to finance their share of CryoEM facility

Current plan:

- Purchase a top-of-the-line setup containing 200 keV and 300 keV microscopes that would enable:
- Single particle analysis (SPN), micro electron diffraction (mED), some tomography, etc
- Start a public tender
- Establish a new research-service group

A new institute at Palacky University Olomouc

A proposal to create a new university institute by integrating regional centers

- Regional Center of Advanced Technologies and Materials (RCPTM)
- Regional center Haná
- Institute of Molecular and Translational Medicine

Czech Institute of Science and Technology (**CIST**) Czech Advanced Technology and Research Institute (**CATRIN**)

A new institute invites participation of IOCB Prague and Faculty Hospital Olomouc to establish joint laboratories and programs to become a prime research center of international significance

OP VVV- International Mobility – call open

supported activities:

- outgoing PhD students & postdocs (up to 7 years after PhD)
- outgoing senior researchers
- incoming postdocs
- incoming senior researchers

mobility duration: **3 – 24 months**

project realization: 6 months after project approval - 31 Dec 2022 budget: monthly units - salary + living allowances; family allowance; 1 joint proposal per IOCB (0,5 – 22 M CZK)

Outgoing activities: Letter of Intent; mandatory 6 months return phase at IOCB (not financed by OP VVV project)

Incoming researchers – less than 1 year in the Czechia

GACR – POSTDOC Individual Fellowship

- in preparation (call spring 2020) – approx. 40 projects/year awarded

long term research stay for postdoc

- **Outgoing postdoc**: 2 years abroad + 1 year at IOCB
- Incoming postdoc: 3 years at IOCB

Eligibility criteria:

- up to 4 years after PhD career breaks excluded
- international experience (Ph.D. or postdoc experience abroad)
- the author of several publications in prestigious journals
- Outgoing: Letter of Intent from foreign institution

Budget: 3 M CZK/project/year (total 9 M CZK/project)

- abroad: salary, living allowance, family allowance
- at IOCB: salary, travel, consumables, services






Investments


Deadline: 20 January 2020

Time and Attendance - OKbase



- As of January 1st, 2020 (trial version in December 2019)
- Incorporated in new HR and Payroll system so Albina will no longer be used for attendance/absenteeism
- Automatically generated attendance records based on agreed workload, however, corrections, overtime etc. allowed
- Time-sheets on one click
- Continuous overview of employees 'working hours, attendance and absenteeism for team leaders
- Online requests and approvals
- Available also on mobile phones
- HR will initiate the training of this new tool
