	<p>Good knowledge of English or German.</p> <p>It is not possible to apply to several fellowship programmes or the Sofja Kovalevskaja Award Programme concurrently.</p> <p>Applicant must have lived outside Germany for a minimum of 12 months in total in the 18-month period prior to the submission deadline.</p> <p>Applicants who have already been sponsored by the Humboldt Foundation are not eligible to apply for the Humboldt Research Fellowship Programme but should turn to the Foundation's Alumni Programme for support for further research stays.</p> <p>It is responsibility of PI to check that two referees and host institution have received the request and complete the form and send the form directly to the foundation.</p> <p>In the case of unanimously rejected applications, a new application will be accepted only after 18 months.</p>
