Conditions / Restrictions	Project proposals must be submitted in parallel to both partner organizations. CZ project proposal must be submitted via the KIS application. You must register in the KIS application using the following link and fill in a project proposal. After finishing your proposal, you shall forward it through your KIS account to the IOCB Director for its approval. The Director shall approve and submit your proposal via his KIS account. All Czech team members must be employees of the CAS. Living expenses of Czech team in Estonia will be covered by the EAS (Accommodation expenses (breakfast included) during research visit; daily allowances - 20 EUR per one day; single travel allowance for a long-distance (Tallinn-Tartu) bus or train tickets.) International transportation and travel insurance will not be covered by the CAS. Days not used during one calendar year cannot be transferred to subsequent years of the
