

Director's Order

RE: The Safety Labelling of the Refrigerators for the Storage of Combustibles

Considering the ever more often proliferating cases of the storage of combustibles in unsuitable types of refrigerators and ice chests,

I DECREE THE FOLLOWING:

- All refrigerators and ice chests (with the exception of refrigerators and ice chests for foodstuffs and beverages) must be labelled with stickers of the safety table: Storage of Combustibles Allowed or with the table: Storage of Combustibles Forbidden, namely also in the English version. The implementation of this measure will be provided by the technical section after consultation with the safety technician of the institute.
- 2. The refrigerators and ice chests labelled in this way at the individual scientific teams but also in the section where chemical substances and preparations are centrally stored will contain only chemical substances and chemical preparations whose physical and chemical characteristics correspond to the safety label of the given refrigerator or ice chest. The implementation of this task is entrusted to the relevant leaders of the individual scientific teams and the heads of storage management.
