

Call info	Barrande Fellowship Program enables Czech Ph.D. students experience a research stay in France, improve their knowledge and learn new skills. These Fellowships support 3-year joint degree Ph.D. study between the Czech Republic and France and realisation of the three 5-months stays in France.
Conditions / Restrictions	Students needs to be registered in a Czech university and needs to have higher education diplomas (Ing. or Mgr.) before their research stay in France. Applicants must be Ph.D. students subscribed simultaneously at Czech and French universities.

	Applicants will find general information on enrolment in a PhD programme in France on the <u>Campus France</u> website. Registration procedures can be found on the website of the targeted doctoral school ( <u>list of all French doctoral schools</u> ). The Joint Degree Ph.D. Study is prepared simultaneously by Czech and French university. All conditions are summarized in the "Cotutelle agreement" about Joint Degree Ph.D. Study" must be signed by both universities. The students commits to providing this agreement before the first departure to France. During 3 years, fellows spend time alternately on both universities. The Fellowship covers three 5-months stays in France. Research visits have to start on 01 Oct or 01 Nov 2021.
	Non-French speaking students may apply for the fellowship if the French supervisor hosting
1	mobility agrees for the research stay to be performed in the English.
	Successful students will receive a Joint University Diploma accredited by both universities. Applications have to be sent electronically by email, as one compressed folder with all documents in PDF format to <u>aia@dzs.cz</u> .

	Fellows are expected to become important players and to strengthen Czech-French
	relationships & collaboration. Applicant must register online via DZS <u>application system</u>
	Application consists of (all documents must be in English):
	1) Application form: scan of signed form;
	2) Academic CV - max. 2 pages;
	3) <b>Cover letter</b> : motivation for applying, subject of your research, reasons for selection of the
	French lab - max. 2 pages; 4) <b>Project description</b> : research topic, specify your research objectives, methodology and
	expected research; a detailed study plan with I timeline, incl. the expected dates of the stay
	abroad; names and contact information of Czech & French supervisors - max 2 pages;
	5) Letter of Invitation from the French supervisor: agreement with your project and the
	joint supervision; willingness to host you at the institution; expected dates of each stay in France;
	6) Letter of Support from the Czech supervisor: agreement with your project and joint
	supervision; expected dates of each stay in France;
	7) A transcript of the most recent achievements (last 2 years of studies)
	Two independent evaluators will assess the applicant's research project on following criteria: • Value of the academic support provided by the applicant's thesis supervisor(s).
	• Professional competence of the applicant to successfully complete his/her research project
	<ul> <li>Importance and relevance of the applicant's research project for his/her professional</li> </ul>
	development.
	• Quality and scientific relevance of the applicant's research project.
