- What we want to do?
 - Study RNA modifications
 - Viruses are perfect model systems
- How we want to do it?
 - Viral RNA digested by nucleases will be analyzed by nanoUPLC/MS (IOCB the best institution- Virology group of Dr. Weber and MS group of Dr. Cvačka)
 - Important once methods established, we can analyze RNA as well as DNA from any systems

Most significant publications in 2015



- Physical and Theoretical Chemistry
- Medicinal and Organic Chemistry
- Biochemistry and Molecular Biology
- Interdisciplinary (within IOCB)

Each group may submit 1 most significant paper published in 2015 per category, but no more that 2 papers total. Semi-autonomous units within larger groups may submit their own papers if the group leader is not listed as co-author. The papers will be pre-screened internally before they are sent to the external panel (IAB members, ad hoc reviewers) as well as to an internal IOCB panel (group leaders and management). 2 – 4 papers in each category will be awarded prizes in the form of group money.

Internal Preselection



 Preselection panel is composed of the external members of IOCB Board and the director:

> Jitka Moravcová Tomáš Obšil Petr Svoboda **Zdeněk** Hostomský

- Typically, only papers with principal or corresponding author from IOCB should be submitted.
- Papers not meeting these criteria may still be submitted, but only work done at IOCB will be judged.
- Print version date counts
- Assignment to categories will be scrutinized
- Clarification re Interdisciplinary vs. Collaborative
- Interdisciplinary: Chemistry Biology
 Computational Experimental
 - Contribution of the analytical techniques component (NMR, MS, x-ray structure analysis) to constitute interdisciplinarity will be evaluated.

Most significant publications 2015



- Submission deadline February 29, 2016
- The winning publications for 2014 and 2015 will be presented at the IOCB off-site conference in May

- The standing of the IOCB most significant paper will be analysed (judges have been asked to select papers that would likely retain their significance and relevance 5 years from publication)
 - Interim analysis of the 2012 winning papers will be performed (incl. citations in 2013, 2014 and 2015) to provide empirical data

Predatory Journals

<u>Predatory journal</u> exploit an Open Access model to profit at the expense of scientific quality.



Czech Republic - 530 articles published in <u>suspected</u> predatory journal of which Academy of Sciences - 61 articles, IOCB - 26 articles (from years 2008-2012)

These journals are not always easily recognizable, they can get into the Web of Science, Scopus etc.

Some features:

- Unsolicited e-mails from the journal calling for article or inviting to the editorial board.
- Peer review process does not exist or it is fictitious, publishing time is very short.
- Common title or misuse of the titles of other journals and conferences.
- It is not possible to check the editorial board, misuse of well-known names.

Defence:

1 / check the unknown journal in the Beall's list of suspicious titles (not 100% reliable)

OP VVV project proposal

IOCB will prepare one joint proposal on medicinal chemistry/chemical biology – provisional title: Reaching Undruggable Targets for New Therapies through Chemical Biology

Project selection committee (Cvačka, Hocek, Hostomský, Jiráček, Jungwirth, Nencka, Pichová, Rulíšek, Veverka) reviewed and considered all short proposals of individual groups and selected those which may fit into the main themes of the project. Several others are still in discussion and are subject to re-focusing.


The director has appointed Prof. M. Hocek as the coordinator of the OP VVV project

The three major themes/workpackages will be:


Protein-protein interactions

The proposal will not cover "classical medicinal chemistry" of enzyme inhibitors or receptor modulators but will focus on undruggable interactions.
