Applicant	An early career researcher (up to 5 years from finishing the PhD in the year of application) with international experience (at least one year of postdoctoral research outside the Czech Republic), excellent results in the field and the potential to develop their own innovative research programme

Call info	The aim of the Nadace Experientia Start-up grant scheme is to support excellent early career researchers in starting their own research group in the Czech Republic and in developing their own independent high-risk high-gain, conceptually novel research direction.

Conditions / Restrictions	<p>The application, in English, should be submitted electronically in PDF format to experientia@experientia.cz.</p> <p>The applicant can only submit 1 application in any 1 year.</p> <p>The subject of the project must be distinct from the applicant's PhD and postdoctoral research topics, and must not overlap with current research taking place at the host institution.</p> <p>The applicant must have at least one year of postdoctoral research experience outside the Czech Republic.</p> <p>The applicant does not need to be an employee of the host institution at the time of application, but must become one by 01 Jan 2022.</p> <p>The work-load of the applicant on the Start-up grant must be 1,0 FTE (100%). A part-time work load is not permissible. If the applicant is successful with further research grant applications, he/she may split their workload between the projects.</p> <p>The host institution pledges to provide the applicant with adequate laboratory space and laboratory equipment, as well as a financial support of 0,7 mil. CZK / year.</p> <p>It is permissible to make changes to the research team during the project duration.</p> <p>The grant recipient is responsible for legitimate and economic spending of the finances, as well as for adherence to all of the conditions.</p> <p>In case of serious circumstances, the financing of the project can be temporarily suspended for the necessary time period.</p> <p>The grant can be transferred to another institution on the condition that this institution agrees to take on all of the obligations linked to the grant. The Foundation (Nadace Experientia) must be informed in writing in advance about the extent and details of such transfer.</p> <p>Unused finances can be transferred into the following calendar year.</p> <p>All received finances must be used by 31 Dec 2024.</p> <p>The recipient will submit an application for an ERC Starting Grant during the Start-up grant period.</p> <p>The recipient may apply for other national and international grants to run in parallel with the Start-up grant.</p> <p>The recipient agrees to present a lecture about the project at the "Pokroky v organické, bioorganické a farmaceutické chemii – Liblice" meeting in November of the last year of the duration of the grant.</p>
