Most significant publications in 2014



- Physical and Theoretical Chemistry
- Medicinal and Organic Chemistry
- Biochemistry and Molecular Biology
- Interdisciplinary (within IOCB)

Each group may submit 1 most significant paper published in 2014 per category. Semi-autonomous units within larger groups may submit their own papers if the group leader is not listed as co-author. The papers will be judged by an external panel (IAB members, *ad hoc* reviewers) as well as by an internal IOCB panel (team leaders and management). Top one third of papers in each category will be awarded prizes in the form of group money.

Most significant publications 2014

Lessons learned from previous years



- Preselection of submission will be done by IOCB management before evaluation by international panel, based on explicit rules:
 - Typically, only papers with principal or corresponding author from IOCB should be submitted.
 - Papers not meeting these criteria may still be submitted, but only work done at IOCB will be judged.
- Assignment to categories will be scrutinized
- Clarification re Interdisciplinary vs Collaborative
- Interdisciplinary: Chemistry Biology

Computational - Experimental

- The cash prize should not exceed 2 x 110K = 220K Kč
- Question re analytical techniques component (NMR, MS, x-ray structure analysis)

Print version date counts

Rules clarifications for papers from external collaborations:

- The IOCB person should be either first or corresponding author
- If the IOCB person is neither, only the contribution from IOCB should be judged

Most significant publications 2014



- 39 submissions for 2014
 - Includes 4 submissions from semiautonomous units
- 43 submissions for 2013 (34 net)

- No submissions from 7 established groups
 - Decreasing number of awards
