Applicant	Young researchers not older than 35 years with an advanced degree who are performing biomedical research in Europe based on methods of molecular biology, including novel analytical concepts.
Criteria/Conditions	The papers submitted will be evaluated with respect to the following five selection criteria: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Independent scientific work</li> <li>2. Creativity (independent of instructions from head of institute)</li> <li>3. Successful practical application of research approach</li> <li>4. Significance of research results for the field of medicine</li> <li>5. Achievement of candidate in relation to his/her age</li> </ol> The main focus is on investigating the molecular biological mechanisms of the human organism and then translating this research into practical findings. The long-term goal is the diagnosis and therapy of those diseases which have yet to be treated successfully.
