Financing



- Investments
 - Requests for 2014 are 260 M transferred to the Methodology Board
- Operating funds
- Personal funds

Operating funds - Group money



- 25% of grant overhead
- 10 K per FTE "pencil money"
- Operating group support (start-up package)
- Gilead grant money
- Bridging grants (100 K-300 K, depending on the budget)
- Acknowledgement of scientific output,
 - quantitative (GEF) see Director's info on Intraweb
 - qualitative (most significant publications)

200 K for group paper

110 K for shared interdisciplinary paper

[up to 50% of the award for significant publication can be converted to personal expenses (136% rate) as an over-limit item]

Bridging grants



- Can be submitted in February, March or April
- Operating costs
- 100 K 300 K, depending on the budget

Group efficiency factor (GEF) quantitative aspect

$$GEF = \frac{J+B+C+D+P+T+S+L}{IS \text{ (Institutional Salaries)}}$$

GEF: period of 2011, 2012 and 2013, normalized for one year

- Version A (excl. Group Leader salary and over limit parts) "bez mzdy vedoucího a nadlimitních složek"
- Version B (incl. Group Leader salary and over limit parts) "včetně mzdy vedoucího a nadlimitních složek"
- Numerator of the GEF (=J+B+C+D+P+T+S+L)

Group vs. Team



- Group hierarchical unit, members of the group report directly to the group leader
- Team an ad hoc arrangement for a particular purpose (hockey team, project team) - coordinator, a dotted line, not a direct reporting relationship
 - team is typically desolved after completion of a task
- Acknowledgments (an exapmple)
 - To my group (members of the group reporting to the group leader)
 - To my team (collaborators from accross the world)

Most significant publications in 2013



- Physical and Theoretical Chemistry
- Medicinal and Organic Chemistry
- Biochemistry and Molecular Biology
- Interdisciplinary (within IOCB)

Each group may submit 1 most significant paper published in 2013 per category. Semi-autonomous units within larger groups may submit their own papers if the group leader is not listed as co-author. The papers will be judged by an external panel (IAB members, ad hoc reviewers) as well as by an internal IOCB panel (team leaders and management). Top one third of papers in each category will be awarded prizes in the form of group money.

Most significant publications in 2013



Deadline for submission:

February 28, 2014

(in exceptional cases extended till March 7)

 Winning publications will be presented as posters at the IOCB off-site Symposium in May

Base Salary Limit for 2014 and on:



150 K per FTE + 600 K, but not more than
 1,125 K for Junior Group
 2,250 K for Senior Group

E.g. SL for a group of 10 FTEs (not including the group leader) would be 1,500 + 600 = 2,100 K

Negotiated salaries of group leaders are not part of base SL. Bonuses - derived from the saved salary money.

Over-limit sources of salary money



- Rolled-over saved salary money
- Academic titles gone from 2014 on
- Excellence award (200 K)
- Group bonuses
- IOCB postdoc (480 K)
- Sabbatical visitor (600 K)
- Director's exception

The FTE number represents an average for the year, from 1.1. to 31.12. 2013, and is used as basis for the initial calculation of the 2014 salary limit.

IOCB Loan



If a group doesn't receive any grant and has no saved salary money from previous years, it will be possible to obtain a loan from IOCB, to slow down the decline in the group size during the first year. The loan can be up to the size of group's adjusted salary limit.
