Information	Within the international project call, providers from both countries support an engagement of their research teams by means of bilateral projects focused on interdisciplinary and perspective topics. Each agency provides financial support only the part of the project implemented by the team from their country (project is divided into national part and international part). Financial support of each part is subject to the conditions based on the rules of the respective provider.
Conditions / Restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A single individual may submit no more than two Project Proposals within all of the public tenders administered by GAČR in a given calendar year for Projects launched in 2022 (subject to the exception provided below), and may be in the role of Applicant in one of the Proposals, and co-Applicant in the other. • If both such Project Proposals submitted by a single individual are selected for funding, he or she may proceed to carry out both Projects, unless any other circumstance resulting out of the pertinent tender document or applicable rules prohibits such involvement in two projects. • Three exceptions to the foregoing are the tenders for JUNIOR STAR projects and the POSTDOC INDIVIDUAL FELLOWSHIP (both INCOMING and OUTGOING), in which an Applicant may submit Project Proposals regardless of any other tenders or calls. An individual who submits a Project Proposal for a JUNIOR STAR or POSTDOC INDIVIDUAL FELLOWSHIP project may submit a maximum of two more Project Proposals, one as Applicant, and the other as Co-applicant. • The project proposal has to be submitted in parallel to both national providers. The Czech and foreign parts of project proposal must correspond to each other in terms of the factual content. The implementation period must be identical in both parts. • The principal investigator of the foreign part of the project cannot be employed in Czech Rep. • High ranking of international part of the project does not qualify the project for funding. Agreement (contract) to provide funding can be signed only if both providers approve the funding. • Recommended workload is at least 0.2 full-time equivalent (FTE) for the applicant and 0.1 FTE for co-applicants. A sum of workloads for one person in all projects funded by GAČR cannot exceed 1 FTE. • A postdoc is a person who obtained their PhD less than 8 years before the starting date of the project (2.1.2014 – 1.1.2022). Career breaks such as maternity leave, parental leave and long-term illness are excluded from the limit. • Salary cap: Only the aliquot part of the salary with maximum at 60 000 CZK (gross salary) at 1,0 FTE is eligible. In other types of contracts – limit for eligibility of the costs is 400 CZK/hour • Rewards and bonuses are not eligible personnel costs • Permitted attachments (to be uploaded only to the GRIS application) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A copy of the project proposal submitted by the foreign partner. - A Letter of Intent verifying the international cooperation or a commitment to perform the necessary work at an institution abroad. - A list of foreign institutions that shall not be asked to evaluate the proposal - A quote from a supplier comprising the proper identification of supplier, the supplied items and the preliminary price – required if the cost of a single tangible asset exceeds 100,000 CZK or if the service(s) from a single supplier represent a value higher than 500,000 CZK/project; - Special licences – if required for the project implementation (check validity of the licence)

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • B - total funding, breakdown of financial items, incl. justification, detailed structure of personnel costs (in Czech) + total funding requested from the foreign provider for the implementation of the international part of the project in EUR; • C (C1, C2, and C3) justification of project proposal, expected results, and a description of the benefits of the international cooperation (C1: up to 10 pages; 6MB); • D (D1 and D2) CV and bibliography of the applicant and co-applicants; (D1: up to 2 pages/person; 1 MB) – CV of foreign applicant (no limit); • E – information on other projects of the applicant and co-applicants • Project proposal has to be converted to PDF format and sent by email to the Project Office on: projectoffice@uochb.cas.cz who will submit it to GA CR via its data box. • Project proposal cannot be modified after the final PDF version is generated! - breach of the electronic seal constitutes the reason for the rejection of the project proposal • The Statutory declaration will be submitted by the Project Office. • International part of the project (if not available by the GA CR deadline) has to be submitted to GA CR by 30 June 2021 at the latest. It is also submitted via GA CR data box. The message has to comprise the reg. no of the project and the date of submission to the foreign provider. (Document will be submitted by the Project office).
Evaluation criteria	<p>Scientific aim (aim of the project proposal), proposed methodology of implementation, type of expected project outcomes; international cooperation, evaluation of previous cooperation with GAČR, adequacy of proposed costs. Evaluation of project proposals is carried out in evaluation panels and discipline committees of GA ČR: (1st stage - 2 expert reviews by panel members + panel evaluation; 2nd stage assessment from foreign experts + panel evaluation). Projects proposals are evaluated separately on the national level, final list of projects with approved funding is published after the comparison and merge of both national evaluation.</p>
