	according to formal conditions and requirements of the Lead Agency (in this case GAČR). The

- Lead Agency will administer the whole evaluation process in accordance with its usual procedures. A budget proposal is submitted separately by both teams to their national agency in accordance with the national conditions. Each provider funds its own national research team.
- A project proposal prepared jointly by the Czech and foreign partner must be submitted to the Lead Agency (i.e. FWF, DFG, SNSF, NCN, ARRS)
- The foreign applicant must, concurrently, submit the foreign part of the proposal to their funding agency (which has a partner agreement with GAČR)
- Applicants may choose which side they choose as the Lead Agency
- A single individual may submit no more than two Project Proposals within all of the public tenders administered by GACR in a given calendar year for Projects launched in 2022 (subject to the exception provided below), and may be in the role of Applicant in one of the Proposals, and co-Applicant in the other.
- If both such Project Proposals submitted by a single individual are selected for funding, he or she may proceed to carry out both Projects, unless any other circumstance resulting out of the pertinent tender document or applicable rules prohibits such involvement in two projects.
- Three exceptions to the foregoing are the tenders for JUNIOR STAR projects and the POSTDOC INDIVIDUAL FELLOWSHIP (both INCOMING and OUTGOING), in which an Applicant may submit Project Proposals regardless of any other tenders or calls. An individual who submits a Project Proposal for a JUNIOR STAR or POSTDOC INDIVIDUAL FELLOWSHIP project may submit a maximum of two more Project Proposals, one as Applicant, and the other as Co-applicant.
- Recommended workload is at least 0,2 full-time equivalent (FTE) for principal investigator and 0,1 FTE for co-investigator. A zero workload for a participant is not permissible. A sum of workloads for one person in all projects financed form GAČR cannot exceed 1 FTE.
- A postdoc is a person who obtained their PhD less than 8 years before the starting date of the project (2.1.2014 1.1.2022). Career breaks such as maternity leave, parental leave and long-term illness are excluded from the limit.
- Salary cap: Only the aliquot part of the salary with maximum at 60 000 CZK (gross salary) at 1,0 FTE is eligible. In other types of contracts limit for eligibility of the costs is 400 CZK/hour
- The costs of bonuses are not eligible for reimbursement.
- Permitted attachments (to be uploaded only to the GRIS application)
  - A Letter of Intent verifying the international cooperation or a commitment to perform the necessary work at an institution abroad.
  - A list of foreign institutions that shall not be asked to evaluate the proposal
  - A quote from a supplier comprising the proper identification of supplier, the supplied items and the preliminary price required if the cost of a single tangible asset exceeds 100,000 CZK or if the service(s) from a single supplier represent a value higher than 500,000 CZK/project;
  - Special licences if required for the project implementation (check validity of the licence)
  - pdf of the project proposal submitted to the foreign Lead agency

Application forms are available on-line in the GRIS web application <a href="http://gris.cz">http://gris.cz</a>. To submit a project proposal to GAČR as the Partner Agencym pick the call **Lead Agency - Partner Organization - 2022** (the registration number will end in the letter **L**).

A joint project proposal describing in detail the planned research for all participants is submitted to a selected foreign agency (i. e. FWF, DFG, SNSF, NCN, ARRS), in accordance with the project submission rules of this agency and by the deadline set by this agency.

• All the forms for submitting a joint project proposal are / will be available on the websites of foreign agencies (FWF, DFG, SNSF, NCN, ARRS).

Project proposal (in GRIS application) consists of the following parts:

- A basic identification data, abstract (1100 characters) and aims of the project (300 characters);
- **B** total funding, breakdown of financial items, incl. justification, detailed structure of personnel costs (in Czech) + **Part B financial plan** total funding requested from the foreign provider for the implementation of the international part of the project in EUR;
- **C** (C2,C3) justification of project proposal and a description of the benefits of the international cooperation
- **Instead of part C1** pdf of the project proposal submitted to the foreign agency must be enclosed as an attachment to GRIS application
- **D** (D1 and D2) CV and bibliography of the applicant and co-applicants; (D1: up to 2 pages/person; 1 MB) CV of foreign applicant (no limit);
- **E** information on other projects of the applicant and co-applicants

An international project must include the elements of well-founded cooperation between teams, the added value of joint research, and the scientific work of both teams must be interlinked closely.
