Call info	<p>The AZV supports applied research projects in healthcare that aim to solve problems related to the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of human diseases. The project may also include necessary basic research activities if they are essential for obtaining the results of applied research.</p>
Conditions / Restrictions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The project may also include necessary basic research activities, if they are immediately followed by applied research activities (these must form the major part of the project). The declared result of the project proposal must be clearly focused on the use in healthcare, its applicability and a clear impact on healthcare must be demonstrated. • The project proponent / co-proposer must have a Ph.D. or its equivalent. • A single person may submit no more than two Project Proposals within this public tender, and may only be in the role of the Applicant in one of the Proposals, and in the role of the co-Applicant in the other. • A minimal workload of at least 0,2 full-time equivalent (FTE) is required for the applicant (PI) and the co-applicants (co-PI). Zero workload (FTE) is not permitted.
