Conditions / Restrictions	The applicant is expected to have his/her own, clearly defined research profile, is working at least at the level of Assistant Professor/Junior Research Group Leader, is able to document independent research work. PhD completed less than 12 years prior to date of application submission.

	<p>Good knowledge of English or German.</p> <p>It is not possible to apply to several fellowship programmes or the Sofja Kovalevskaja Award Programme concurrently.</p> <p>Applicant must have lived outside Germany for a minimum of 12 months in total in the 18-month period prior to the submission deadline.</p> <p>German nationals (or those who have obtained their school and university or university and PhD qualifications in Germany) are eligible to apply if they have been located abroad on the assumption of permanence for at least five years.</p> <p>Applicants who have already been sponsored by the Humboldt Foundation are not eligible to apply for the Humboldt Research Fellowship Programme but should turn to the Foundation's Alumni Programme for support for further research stays.</p> <p>It is responsibility of the applicant to check that two referees and the host institution have received the request, completed the form and sent it directly to the foundation (via the online link provided to them).</p> <p>In the case of unanimously rejected applications, a new application will be accepted only after 18 months.</p>
