Call info	The aim of the programme is to establish contacts, to develop cooperation and support the mobility of researchers cooperating in international projects of basic research.
Conditions / Restrictions	The tender documentation is only available in Czech. The proposal for a joint research project has to be prepared simultaneously by the Czech research team (based on MEYS call conditions https://www.msmt.cz/vyzkum-a-vyvoj-2/vyzva-k-podavani-navrhu-spolecnych-cesko-rakouskych-10) and the Austrian investigators (based on Austrian Agency for Education and Internalisation (OeAD) call conditions https://asp.sop.co.at/oead/antrag?call=2023_CZ). The Czech and Austrian parts of the project must be identical in terms of content and research themes. Austrian side: Only new project partnerships can be funded under this programme. Czech side: Only two rounds of the funding can be received by a team with the same composition.

	<p>Austrian side: Project applications submitted by early-stage researchers as well as project applications with involvement of PhD/doctoral students and/or female researchers will be prioritized.</p> <p>Several Czech research institutions can participate, however only one main proposer has to be designated on the Czech side of the joint research project. The proposal has to be submitted only via data box (datová schránka) vidaaawt – this will be arranged by the Project office.</p> <p>The proposal has to be originally signed, stamped and dated by the legal representatives of all participating Czech institutions.</p>
