Call info	Visegrad Taiwan Scholarships support PhD candidates (early-stage researchers), and doctoral and postdoctoral scholars (experienced researchers) from V4 countries to undertake 1-10 month visits at specific universities in Taiwan.
Conditions / Restrictions	Applicants must be citizens of V4 countries. Applicants for the Scholarship Program shall submit no more than one application within one deadline.
	The list of eligible host universities/institutions in Taiwan is published on the Fund's website prior to each deadline.
	Minimum applicable length of the scholarship is 1 month; maximum length is 10 months. In general, longer scholarship periods are preferred.
	Successful applicants are eligible to apply for the Scholarship Program again; however, the maximum term of overall support to one scholar is 20 months.
	The areas of supported studies/research shall be: a) Nanotechnology, b) Electrotechnical industry, c) Biotechnology, d) Information technology, e) Public health, f) Social sciences and humanities, g) Other.
	All forms as well as uploaded documents must be written in the English language and duly submitted before each deadline.
	The tuition fees connected with the studies/research of V4 scholars at selected Taiwanese higher-education institutions shall be covered by the respective host.
