Call info	Life Sciences Research Foundation (LSRF) identifies and funds exceptional young scientists at a critical juncture of their training in all areas of basic life sciences and provides a high-quality peer-review service to anyone (individual, foundation, company) wishing to sponsor a fellow who shares their vision of important research.
Conditions / Restrictions	Applicants must have received their PhD degrees no more than 5 years prior to the application deadline date. Applicants must have begun (or will begin) working in proposed hosting lab between 1 Aug 2021 and 31 Jul 2023. U.S. citizens are eligible to work in any geographic location, non-U.S. citizens must work in a U.S. laboratory. Supervisor and all referee's names and email addresses must be listed by the applicant before the deadline Sat 1 Oct 2022 8:00 pm EST.

	Verify that all email addresses listed are correct and current. Applicants will not be able to change referees or to upload any additional material after the deadline Sat 1 Oct 2022 8:00 pm EST. A laboratory may have only one LSRF fellow at a time. LSRF does not require a budget, college transcripts, animal certification documents or any type of visa documents. No indirect or overhead costs may be charged to the fellowship. August 1 is the only award activation date. Awardees are required to submit annual scientific progress reports and the host institution is required to submit annual financial reports. Awardees are required to attend LSRF Annual Meetings held in October. Fellows can ask LSRF to withhold up to \$5,000/year. If the fellow moves to a non-profit institution in the U.S. the escrow fund (up to \$15,000) will be reverted to the fellow as a one-time mini-grant.
	The award may not be used for any other salary but the awardee, nor is it meant to
	provide general support for the research supervisor or lab. All equipment purchased with the research allowance funds is considered the
	awardee's property to take with them at the end of the award period.
