Criteria	Applicants must be women scientists aged 40 or less on 31 Dec 2022 with a Ph.D. degree in the Formal sciences (e.g. Information Technology and Information Science and Mathematics) or Life and environmental sciences (e.g. Biological, Clinical, Basic Medical and Health Sciences) – see guidelines for full list.  Relevant research to be implemented in the Czech Republic for the length of the following one year.
	If animal experiments are carried out, these must be described in detail. Their necessity or the lack of alternatives must be justified.  The award of 200,000 CZK to be used to support research in the Czech Republic.  The winners agree to participate in media training, to participate in the official events organized in 2023/2024 around the topic "For Women in Science".  The winners agree to keep the announcement of the results confidential until the official announcement.  The winners expressly authorize UNESCO and the L'Oréal Group including all subsidiaries to reproduce, represent and use their Image, in the Czech Republic and worldwide.
