	<p>Good knowledge of English or German.</p> <p>It is not possible to apply to several fellowship programmes or the Sofja Kovalevskaja Award Programme concurrently.</p> <p>It is not possible to break up the research stay.</p> <p>Applicant must have lived outside Germany for a minimum of 12 months in total in the 18-month period prior to the submission deadline, must have not been funded by German sources of financing for more than 6 out of the last 18 months and must not have been undertaking a PhD at a German institution in the last 18 months.</p> <p>German nationals (or those who have obtained their school and university or university and PhD qualifications in Germany) are eligible to apply if they have been located abroad on the assumption of permanence for at least five years.</p> <p>Applicants who have already been sponsored by the Humboldt Foundation are not eligible to apply for the Humboldt Research Fellowship Programme but should turn to the Foundation's Alumni Programme for support for further research stays.</p> <p>It is responsibility of the applicant to check that two referees and the host institution have received the request, completed the form and sent it directly to the foundation (via the online link provided to them).</p> <p>In the case of unanimously rejected applications, a new application will be accepted only after 18 months.</p>
