Proposals will be evaluated under the Lead Agency principle, i.e. the project proposal is evaluated only by the Lead agency. A joint project proposal must be prepared according to formal conditions and requirements of the Lead Agency (in this case GAČR). The Lead Agency will administer the whole evaluation process in accordance with its usual procedures. A budget proposal is submitted separately by both teams to their national agency in accordance with the national conditions. Each provider funds its own national research team.
