Conditions / Restrictions	Select call for application from the scholarship database www.funding-guide.de Application portal opens about 6 weeks before the deadline A) early October (B) mid March. Applicants who have been resident in Germany for longer than 15 months at the application deadline are not eligible. The grant is non-renewable. Language skills: for the natural sciences and engineering, proof of good English language skills is acceptable if English is spoken at the host institute. Certificates, proof of credits, certifications and translations may be scanned in non-certified form and uploaded to the DAAD portal. The DAAD may request certified copies of the documents.
Proposal consists of	The application must be submitted online through the DAAD Portal https://www.mydaad.de/en/ , which opens about 6 weeks before the deadline.
