Call info	The postdoctoral fellowships programme, Junior Leader "la Caixa" is aimed at hiring excellent researchers (of any nationality) who wish to continue their research career in Spanish or Portuguese territory. The objectives of this programme are to foster high quality, innovative research and to support the best scientific talents by providing them with an attractive, competitive environment in which to conduct excellent research.
Conditions / Restrictions	The date of obtaining the PhD will be understood as the date the doctoral thesis is defended. Special deadlines apply for candidates with interrupted research careers. Should an applicant hold more than one doctorate (PhD), the above-mentioned period will

be calculated for the first degree earned. Candidates must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in Spain (for applications to Spain) or Portugal (for applications to Portugal) for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the call deadline. Candidates should state the preferred research centre and attach a declaration of interest **letter** signed by a researcher of the research center. The fellowship holder may change the centre chosen before the start of the fellowship. The fellowship will start when the chosen candidate and the research centre reach an agreement regarding their admission. A mandatory international and/or intersectoral secondment of 3 to 6 months must take place within the research project, can be performed in a single period or can be divided into shorter periods with a maximum of 6 months. (A declaration of interest letter from the secondment supervisor will be requested from the fellow before the start of the fellowship at the host institution) The fellowship also includes a mixed training programme (face-to-face and online) on transversal skills, innovation and leadership. Three sessions will be held: at the start of the fellowship, during the second year, and during the third year. Each session will last between 2 and 5 days, and attendance is required for all fellows from the same call, regardless of their discipline. "la Caixa" Foundation will cover all costs for these sessions, as well as the fellows' accommodation and travel costs. Early after recruitment, fellows will be required to establish a personal Career Development Plan (CDP). Fellowships are granted exclusively for on-site projects to carry out full-time research activity in the research centre's facilities. These fellowships are incompatible with any other paid work, grant or fellowship that covers more than 10% of the annual amount given for salary costs, unless authorized by the "la Caixa" Foundation. Fellowships are compatible with other competitive funds that complement this fellowships, upon the authorization of the "la Caixa" Foundation. The fellowship will not be compatible with a permanent employment contract from an institution other than the host institution. The reference letters must be written in English. • A declaration of interest letter signed by a researcher of the research center (a template available in an Application Platform). If relevant: An ethic table pointing out the ethical aspects of the project proposal. If a candidate claims an exception due to a career break, the relevant supporting documents must be provided. The process is comprised of three parts: Evaluation criteria Eligibility screening • Remote evaluation (preselection; evaluation panel made up of 2-4 experts) • Face-to-face evaluation (Final selection) The redress procedure possible submit by an email within 7 calendar days from the date the results notification is sent.
