Call info	Annually, the Azrieli foundation grants up to 18 Fellowships in STEM fields to highly qualified postdoctoral researchers without regard to religion, gender, age or ethnicity. Fellows are expected to pursue a two-year period of research in Izraeli academic institution
Conditions / Restrictions	The Azrieli International Postdoctoral Fellowship is open to candidates who have been awarded their PhD no earlier than November 1, 2020, in all countries except Israel. Candidates currently enrolled in a PhD program may apply as long as they obtain their degree no later than June 1, 2024.  At the time of application, all applicants are required to have an academic sponsor who is a faculty member at one of the eligible Israeli institutions: Bar-Ilan University, Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, Reichman University, Technion - Israel Institute of Technology, Tel Aviv University, The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, University of Haifa and Weizmann Institute of Science.
