**Joint research part** of each project proposal should be written **in English** and must be **identical** in both countries. This part should be submitted using a unified form, available at each side's websites.

Font: Times New Roman 11; line spacing: 1.5.

**Joint research part** of the project proposal should be up to 10 pages, including figures (not including bibliography) and should include the following sections:

- 1. Abstract (max 1500 characters including spaces)
- 2. <u>Scientific background and state of the art</u>: Scientific background, including an overview of the field of research around the world, noting the relative advantage of the proposed research;
- 3. Research objectives and specific aims: The purpose of the research;
- 4. <u>Detailed description of the proposed research</u>: Working hypothesis, research program and methods, and preliminary results;
- 5. Significance, importance, innovation, and potential benefits of the proposed research;
- 6. <u>Applicability</u>: Expected <u>uses</u> and future technological development;
- 7. <u>Cooperation vectors between the research groups</u>: Proposed modes of cooperation, their benefits and how they contribute to the research;
- 8. <u>Work plan and Gantt</u>: The work plan will be summarized in a schedule diagram. A verbal description of the work steps must be included. Each stage will be defined by a start time and an end time.
