Call info	The fellowship is awarded to researchers or PhD students who use microscopy methods, are developing new microscopy approaches or analyse microscopy data. As a parallel (ThermoFisher/CSMS) competition exists for research projects involving electron/ion microscopy, the CSMS fellowship is open to projects involving types of microscopy other than electron microscopy. Projects with a combination of methods (incl. electron microscopy) are eligible.
Conditions / Restrictions	The applications should be submitted electronically through the online submission system https://forms.gle/F437dZhydmyvSKSb9 The upper age limit of 35 years is reached in the first year of the fellowship (the cutoff date of birth is 1 Jan 1989, the age limit can be extended by maternity and parental leave). Acknowledgement of the Czechoslovak Microscopic Society must be included in publications, posters, lectures, etc.

Evaluation criteria	Evaluation is by a CSMS committee set up ad hoc based on the topics of the projects submitted. The evaluation is in 2 rounds: in the first round, projects are assessed within thematic panels (1 – natural sciences and medicine, 2 – materials science, 3 –

	instrumentation and optics), in the second round, projects are assessed across panels. Evaluation criteria: quality of a proposed project, applicant quality, publication record.
Research areas	Microscopy, development of new microscopy approaches, analysis of microscopy data (not electron microscopy projects, except where in combination with other types of microscopy).
