Conditions / Restrictions	<p>Select call for application from the scholarship database www.funding-guide.de</p> <p>Application portal opens about 6 weeks before the deadline (A) early October (B) mid March. Applicants who have been resident in Germany for longer than 15 months at the application deadline are not eligible.</p> <p>The grant is non-renewable.</p> <p>It is not possible to divide the funding up within the funding period.</p> <p>Indicate your desired funding period in application, but the funding period will be determined by selection committee during selection process. The scholarship cannot be extended.</p> <p>Language skills: for the natural sciences and engineering, proof of good English language skills is acceptable if English is spoken at the host institute.</p> <p>Certificates, proof of credits, certifications and translations may be scanned in non-certified form and uploaded to the DAAD portal. The DAAD may request certified copies of the documents.</p>

Proposal consists of	<p>The application must be submitted online through the DAAD Portal https://www.mydaad.de/en/, which opens about 6 weeks before the deadline.</p> <p>Documents to be uploaded to the DAAD portal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Online application form • CV in tabular form (max. 3 pages) • List of publications (max. 10 pages) • Description of research proposal (max. 10 pages) • Time schedule of planned research • Motivation Letter (statement about the academic and personal reasons for the planned research project in Germany and what will you gain from your project in Germany (personally, professionally, for your career) (1-2 pages) • Letter confirming supervision by an academic adviser in Germany, which refers to the applicant's proposal and confirms that the host institute will provide a workplace • Letter of recommendation from a university teacher (for doctoral students, from the supervisor of your doctoral thesis) which provides information about your qualifications. (DAAD-form) • University degree certificate indicating final grade(s) • Other support documents (e.g. training and employment certificates) • Language certificate in the language in which the research is carried out (likely English in the case of natural sciences) • German or English translations of documents submitted in national language • All university certificates on all annual examinations with individual grade(s), incl. explanation of grading system
Evaluation criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Academic Qualifications (achievements, academic progress, knowledge of the language, publications, lectures, conferences) • Quality of research project (quality of proposal and preparation, originality, feasibility and consistency of study plan and schedule, integration into overall PhD) • Potential of applicant (career prospects, motivation relevance, reasons for choosing Germany/host institution, importance of research stay for professional development, additional skills, civic engagement, etc.) • The selection committee also gives due consideration to equal opportunities.
