Conditions / Restrictions	<p>Applicants should have no more than 18 months of postdoctoral research experience at the time of the application deadline.</p> <p>Applicants must have completed their Ph.D. degree no more than 24 months prior to the application deadline date.</p> <p>U.S. citizens are eligible to work in any geographic location, non-U.S. citizens must work in a U.S. laboratory.</p> <p>No more than 1 fellowship under a particular sponsor/mentor in any award year will be funded. There can be more than one Fellow in 1 lab funded by the JCC Fund. They would be a 2nd or 3rd year Fellow.</p> <p>No indirect costs are paid.</p> <p>Each year, all fellows are invited and expected to attend a weekend Symposium “Challenges in Biomedical Sciences: Research from the Fellows Perspective” organised by the JCC Fund. The second year fellows report on the status of their projects in the form of an abstract and poster presentation, whereas the third year fellows have a 15-minute presentation.</p>
