	for Europe and Foreign Affairs to enable French higher education institutions to
	attract top foreign students to enroll in their masters and PhD programs.
	Designed to help French higher education institutions attract the best possible
	applicants to MSc programs and PhD internship in the face of stiff international
Conditions / Restrictions	competition. The program is designed for foreign nationals. Candidates who hold French
Conditions / Restrictions	citizenship, even if they are also a citizen of another country, are not eligible.

	Knowledge of French language is requested in level sufficient for the studies. Applicants for master studies may request one additional month for language courses, from August 2025. However, the language training must be mentioned in the application file; it cannot be requested after the fact. Applications are put forward by the French host institutions, which agree to enroll the grantees in the program for which they are selected. The Eiffel program does not cover tuition. Recipients of grants from the French government are exempted from paying the application and registration fees charged by public institutions. An application nominating a student rejected in a previous competition will not be accepted, even if the application was submitted by a different institution or in another field of study. Students who have previously received an Eiffel master's or doctoral scholarship are not eligible to receive another at the master's level. Institutions may nominate for a doctoral scholarship a candidate previously awarded a scholarship at the master's level. Master level: Candidates already studying in France are ineligible. Doctoral level: Students enrolled in academic programs abroad have priority over students already in France. Each institution may nominate a maximum of 40 applicants at the master's level. Applications submitted directly by students or by foreign educational institutions will be rejected.
Proposal consists of	1st step:
	- You have to choose by yourself the French institution according to your project of
	study. Any French higher education institution can apply - You may contact the International Relations department of the university/school
	trough their website, by email or phone, to know the deadline for the submission of
	applications.
	2nd step:
	- If your French university/school has decided to support your application to the Eiffel scholarship, they will send you the application form and help you fill it out.
	- Finally, they will send the application on your behalf.
	Applications are submitted by the French host institutions, which agree to enroll
	the grantees in the program for which they are selected.

	institutions with which they are affiliated.

	scholarship on the basis of their academic performance as mentioned in their
	application form. Students with outstanding academic performance will be
	preferred for the scholarship.
